MidWinter IBT

For the last three days I've had the privileged to listen to the streaming audio of the MidWinter IBT meeting in Rayne, LA. Fun stuff.

The advance Agenda had a total of 25 Motions. The first announcement was to add two more motions.

Day one managed to get through all 25 of the committee reports and 5 motions.

The New Orleans, LA unit is newly combined and wanted a more accurate name.

The request to move \$103 K from the Int. Rally reserve fund was accompanied with much explanation and justification and just a hint of apology. Changes to the funding for the MidWinter meeting was discussed. Hey I know this is boring but you can still read through it. After all I had to sit through it in real time. At this point the meeting

adjourned for the day.

Day two began with: A restructuring of the club financial report that was discussed extensively.

Followed by discussions on Budget preparation and Financial Statements.

A relatively brief discussion was held on revisions to the example CBL. This was followed by 6 more motions on expenses including officer reimbursement. These were given to an ad hoc committee to report back at the upcoming IBT meeting.

Finally they got to the motion regarding a proposed \$20 dues increase. An extensive and sometimes colorful discussion ensued with comments from all across the spectrum. Too much, not enough, man up and pay. Stuff along that line.

Added motion 26 addresses significant club restructuring including elimination of Int. 3rd

VP, consolidation from 12 Regions to 7. The motion charged the 20/20 Group with developing a plan and presenting it back to the IBT in June. And so ends the Seminar.

Saturday's meeting went relatively quickly. The highlights are. Motion 12 which reduced Int. & Region travel reimbursement passed with an average 25% decrease in rates. Motion 14 to raise the dues passed as a \$10 increase. Motion 15 to eliminated proportional voting failed. Motion 16 to changed the IBT meeting schedule failed. Motion 17 budgeting the Marketing Program passed. Motion 18 , a combination of motions 18-25 on Ethics & Greivance procedures passed. With the exception of motion 20 which did not. And so ended the 2010 MidWinter IBT.

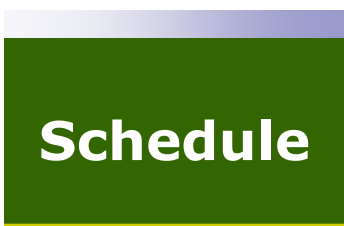

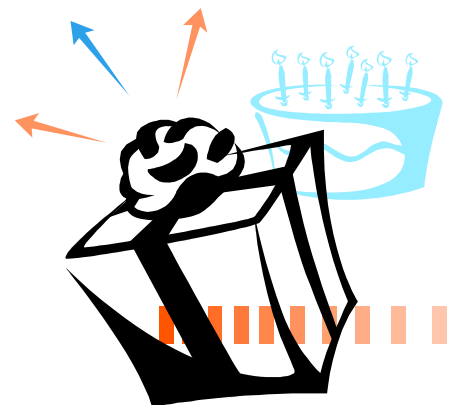

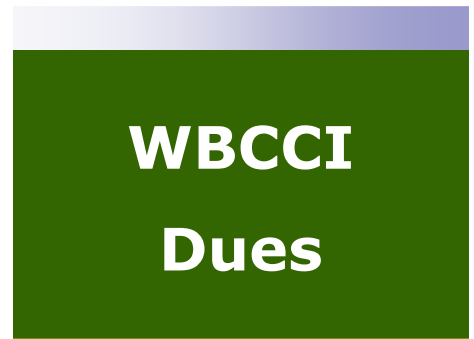

Join us for travel, camaraderie and fun!

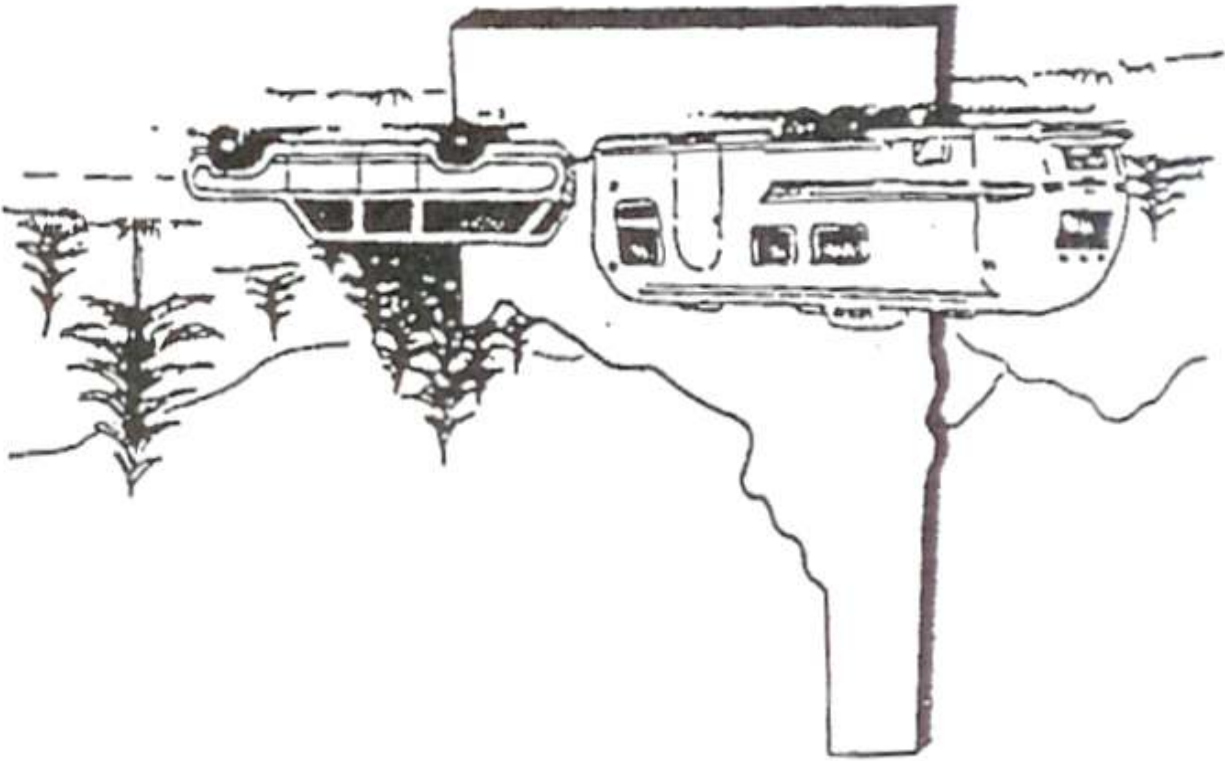
