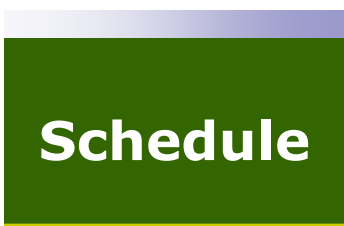

Rally recipe

PARTY CHEESE BREAD

Yield: 8 servings

½ C butter, melted
 2 T lemon juice
 2 T Dijon mustard
 1 ½ tsp garlic powder
 ½ tsp onion powder
 ½ tsp celery salt or crushed celery seeds
 1 round loaf sourdough bread (1 lb)
 1 lb Monterey Jack, Mozzarella, pepper jack, Swiss or a cheese of your choice, cut into thin slices.

In a small bowl, combine the first six ingredients; set aside. Cut bread diagonally into 1 inch slices to within ½ inch of bottom of loaf. Repeat cuts in opposite direction. Arrange cheese slices in cuts. Drizzle butter mixture over bread.

Wrap loaf in foil; place on a baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes. Uncover; bake 10 minutes longer or until cheese is melted.

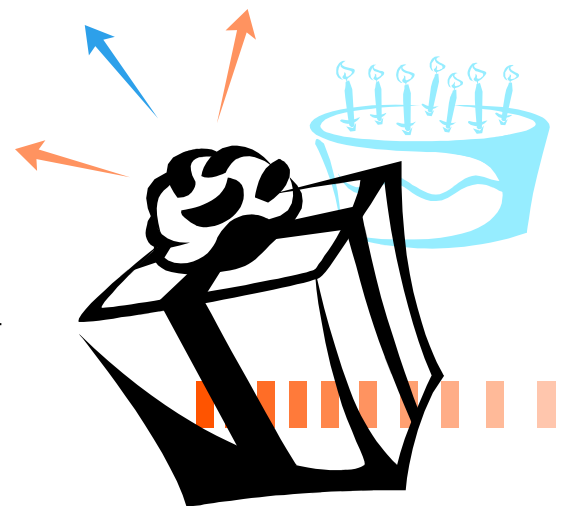

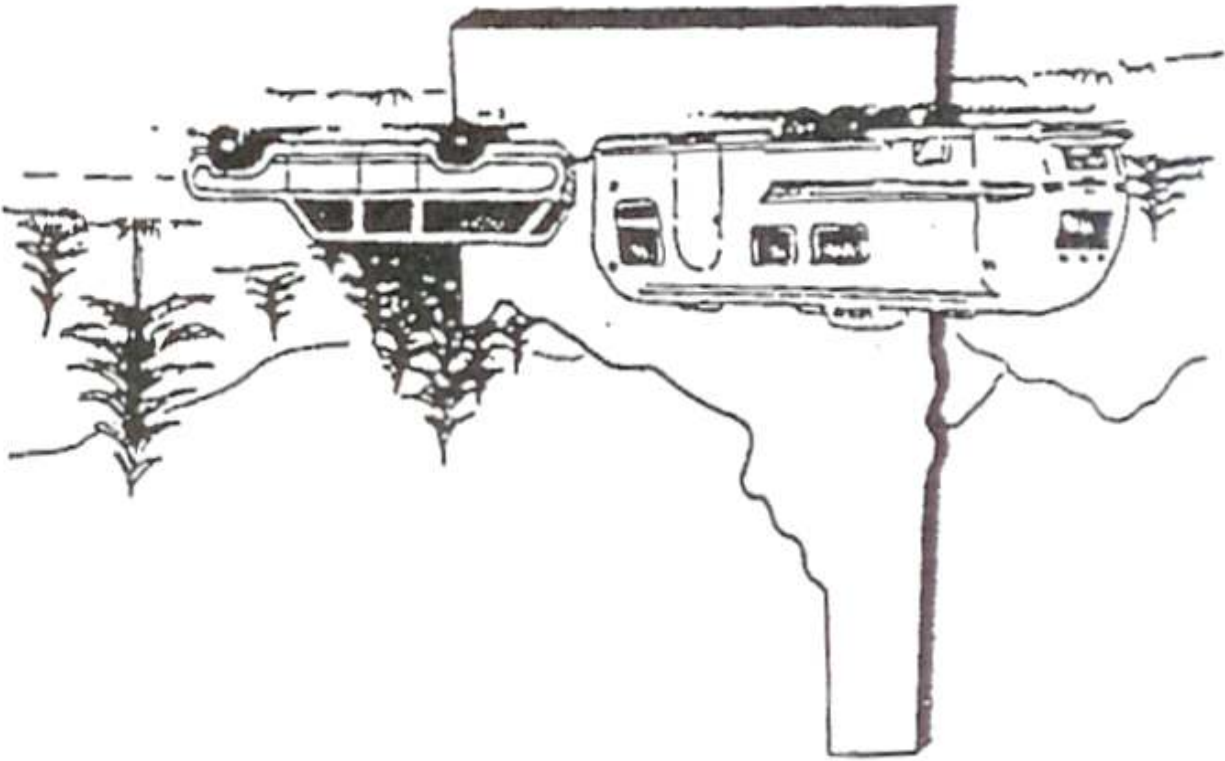
