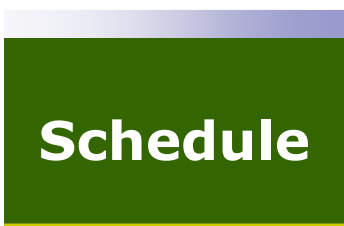

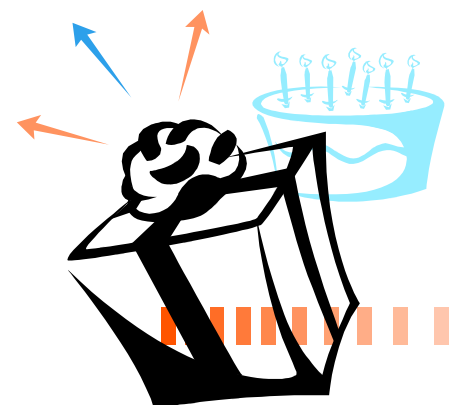
Life's Imponderables®

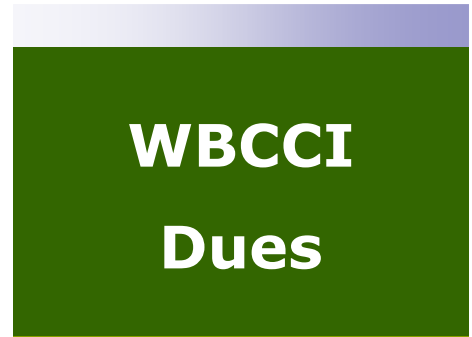

Locally, the Idaho Unit of WBCCI has traveled the region, exploring landmarks and points of interest..

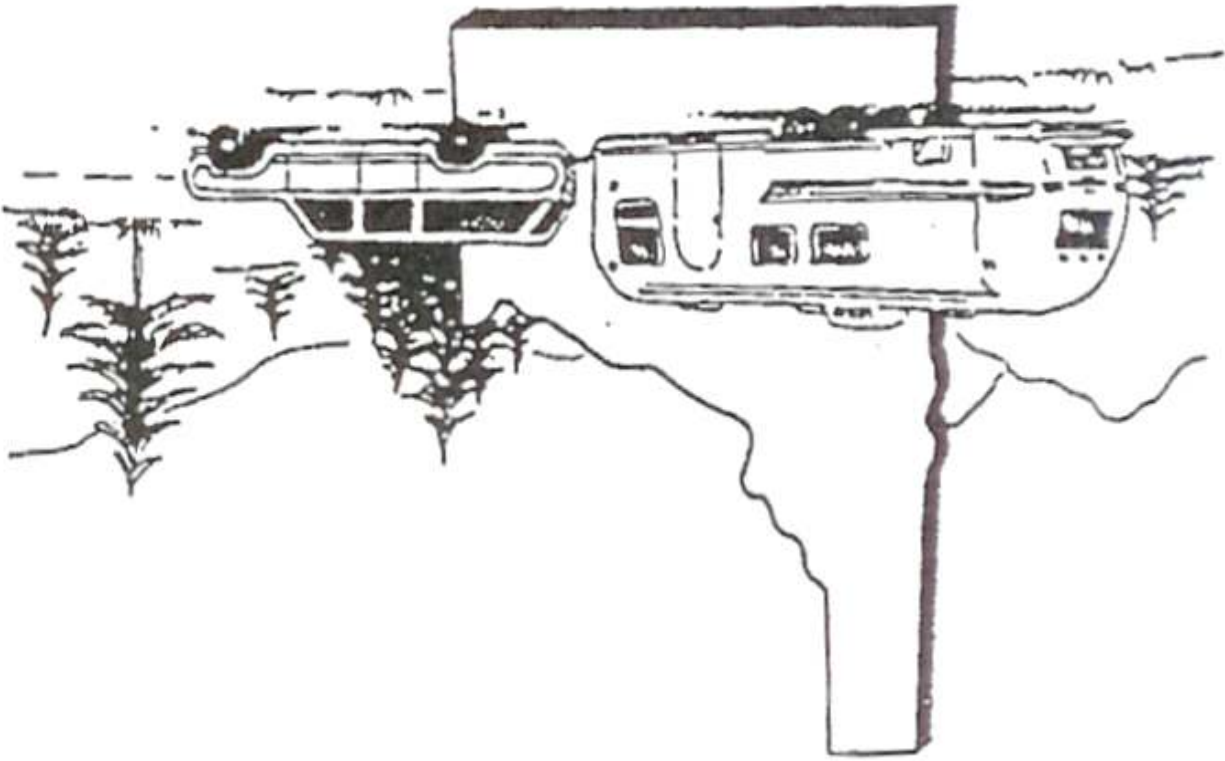
